Sheffield Wednesday is looking for an experienced electrician to join our professional maintenance team on a full time basis. As the club's maintenance electrician, it will be your responsibility to ensure the correct operation of the electrical systems across all SWFC sites.

You will be responsible for the annual inspection & testing of the stadium as well as all other electrical reports required for the safe operation of the business.

You will carry out planned preventative maintenance where required and will also integrate into the maintenance dept to carry out a variety of different roles as required by the club.

Your main duties will be (but not limited to)

- Electrical inspection & testing of all SWFC sites & reports provided to local authorities.
- Annual PAT testing of all portable appliances owned by the club
- Fault diagnosis & rectification where required
- Electrical installations as required by the club
- Lighting checks & repairs at all sites
- Matchday electrical cover & set up
- Assist the maintenance team in various non electrical tasks (e.g. seat repairs)
- Emergency lighting checks & repairs & logbook keeping as required by local authorities.
- Floodlight maintenance, including painting switch gear housings, lamp replacement, ignitor & ballast repairs etc.
- Basic repairs to fire alarm & access control systems.
