You will have input on the long term strategy of the technological infrastructure at the club, and also provide advice, support and guidance to the owner and his wider business interests.

- Support the operation of the technology functions within the club
- Support standard business systems and processes
- Provide support and guidance to the Community Programme facilities in order to meet their requirements
- Support the matchday IT operation
- Maintaining the asset register and accounting for the location of equipment
- Carrying out software updates and patches to servers and workstations

- Maintaining server backups
- Equipment and software installations
